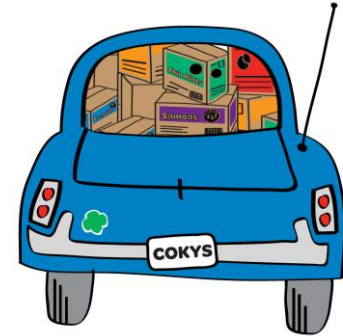


Planning for Pick Up

- Make sure you have enough room in your vehicle(s)!
PRO TIP: EMPTY YOUR VEHICLE AHEAD OF TIME.
- It takes **two** adults, one to drive through the pick up stations. The other stands outside the vehicle to supervise counting and loading.
- Please leave children and pets at home, there is heavy equipment in use. It's not safe.
- Arrive at your designated pick up location promptly at your scheduled time. **Please do not arrive early, traffic jams ensue.**
- Space limitations prevent troops from sorting cookies for girls/parents on site. Please divvy up cookies elsewhere.
- Have a backup plan to pick up cookies if you have a last minute emergency.
- Print out from eBudde and bring a copy of your initial order with you so you can verify if needed.



HOW MANY COOKIES WILL FIT?

Please verify in advance that you have ample vehicle(s) space for your entire Troop order, including any Initial Order Rewards.

Partial orders cannot be picked up.

Vehicle Type	Number of cases
Compact car	23
Hatchback car	30
Mid-size sedan	35
Sport utility vehicle	60
Station wagon	75
Minivan (seats in)	75
Pick-up truck (full bed)	100
Cargo van (seats in)	200

Jan. 12 Count & Go



1. At check in, staff will provide your Troop pick up ticket (Bubble Sheet) for your windshield. Bubble sheet shows your number of cases by flavor.
Using multiple vehicles? Please wait until all vehicles have arrived to check-in, then form a caravan with the lead car in front.
2. Count and load by each flavor, this helps with accuracy. Troop Cookie Managers will initial each flavor and verify as cookies are loaded in vehicle(s) on paperwork provided at check-in.
 - Cookies are to be counted twice: first as they are pulled from the pallet, and again BEFORE loading. Count before, not during, loading process.
3. Once cookies are loaded, proceed to check-out to finalize paperwork and receive any Initial Order Rewards (A1 Fargo troops will receive rewards at check in).
Verify counts and exit when cookies/rewards are signed for.

**IF A TROOP IS UNSURE IT HAS THE CORRECT NUMBER/VARIETIES OF CASES,
DO NOT LEAVE PICK UP SITE. ASK STAFF TO RECOUNT.**

Once volunteer/vehicles leave the site, staff *cannot* address shortage claims.
Troops are financially responsible for ALL cookies signed for.

Cookies not picked up must be returned to inventory and initial order cancelled.
Sadly, girls forfeit any initial order rewards if order is cancelled.
